**The A458 Trunk Road (Church
Street, Welshpool, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2022**

Made 8 November 2022

Coming into force 14 November 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Church Street, Welshpool, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 14 November 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 09:00 hours on 14 November 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road known as Church Street, Welshpool, Powys that extends from its intersection with The Cross junction to a point 78 metres north of that intersection.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
