**The A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads at
Junction 3 (Pencaledog
Interchange), Anglesey)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2022**

Made 13 May 2022

Coming into force 16 May 2022

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A55 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A55 Trunk Road (Slip Roads at Junction 3 (Pencaledog Interchange), Anglesey) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2022 and this Order comes into force on 16 May 2022.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 London to Holyhead trunk road;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 18:00 hours on 16 May 2022 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the lengths of the westbound and eastbound exit and entry trunk road slip roads at Junction 3 (Pencaledog Interchange), Anglesey.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 12 months.
