Enforcement cost recovery notices

Appeals against enforcement cost recovery notices

- 23.**—(1) The person required to pay costs under paragraph 22(1) may appeal—
- (a) against the decision of the regulator to impose the requirement to pay costs,
 - (b) against the decision of the regulator as to the amount of those costs, or
 - (c) for any other similar reason.
- (2) The grounds for appeal are—
- (a) that the decision was based on an error of fact;
 - (b) that the decision was wrong in law;
 - (c) that the amount of the costs is unreasonable;
 - (d) that the decision was unreasonable for any other reason;
 - (e) any other similar reason.
