The A5 Trunk Road (Llyn Ogwen,
Conwy County Borough)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023

Made 16 March 2023

Coming into force 21 March 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A5 trunk road, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1(1), 2(1), 2(2) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

The Welsh Ministers have consulted with the Chief Officer of North Wales Police and given notice of their intention to make this Order in accordance with regulations 5(1) and 6(1) of the Secretary of State's Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1990(2).

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A5 Trunk Road (Llyn Ogwen, Conwy County Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 21 March 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“y *gefnffordd*”) means the A5 London to Holyhead trunk road.

Prohibition of waiting

3. Except as provided in article 4, no person may cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time, on any day on the lengths of the trunk road specified in the Schedule to this Order.

Exemptions

4. A person may cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the lengths of the trunk road specified in article 3 for so long as may be necessary to enable—

- (a) a person to board or alight from a vehicle;
- (b) goods to be loaded on or unloaded from the vehicle;
- (c) the vehicle to be used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes; or
- (d) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations—
 - (i) building, industrial or demolition operations;
 - (ii) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - (iii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the lay-by; or
 - (iv) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to, the length of the lay-by of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or any electronic communications apparatus as defined in paragraph 5 of Schedule 3A to the Communications Act 2003⁽¹⁾;
- (e) a vehicle to be used in the service of a local authority or a water authority in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;
- (f) the vehicle to take petrol, oil, water or air from any garage situated on or adjacent to the said length of the trunk road;
- (g) a vehicle to stop when the person in control of it—
 - (i) is required by law;
 - (ii) is obliged to stop in order to avoid an accident;
 - (iii) is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside their control; or
 - (iv) is acting upon the direction, or with the permission, of a police constable, police

SCHEDULE

The length of the northern side of the trunk road that extends from a point 66 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the unclassified road adjacent to Ogwen Cottage to a point 2,447 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with that unclassified road.

The length of the southern side of the trunk road that extends from a point 66 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the unclassified road adjacent to Ogwen Cottage to a point 1,339 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with that unclassified road.

The length of the southern side of the trunk road that extends from a point 1,475 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with the unclassified road adjacent to Ogwen Cottage to a point 1,995 metres east of the centre-point of its junction with that unclassified road.
