## The Judicial Offices (Sitting in Retirement – Prescribed Offices and Descriptions) (Wales) Regulations 2023

### Interpretation

#### 2. In these Regulations—

“Legally qualified member of the Adjudication Panel for Wales” (“*aelod wedi ymgymhwyso yn gyfraith o Banel Dyfarnu Cymru*”) means a person (“P”) who when appointed to a prescribed office satisfied the following description—

- (a) P satisfied the judicial appointment eligibility condition on a five-year basis;
- (b) P was an advocate or solicitor in Scotland of at least five years’ standing;
- (c) P was a member of the Bar of Northern Ireland; or
- (d) P had such legal experience as the Welsh Ministers considered suitable.
