(Nid yw'r nodyn hwn yn rhan o'r Offeryn)

Mae'r Offeryn hwn yn diwygio Rheoliadau Arwyddion Traffig 2016 a Chyfarwyddydau Cyffredinol Arwyddion Traffig 2016, a elwir gyda'i gilydd yn Rheoliadau a Chyfarwyddydau Cyffredinol Arwyddion Traffig 2016 ("Offeryn 2016"). Mae'r diwygiadau hyn yn berthnasol i Gymru yn unig ac maent yn ganlyniadol i Orchymyn Ffyrdd Cyfyngedig (Terfyn Cyflymder 20 mya) (Cymru) 2022 ac yn atodol i'r Gorchymyn hwnnw, sy'n gostwng y terfyn cyflymder cyffredinol ar gyfer ffyrdd cyfyngedig o 30 milltir yr awr i 20 milltir yr awr yng Nghymru o 17 Medi 2023. Mae cyfeiriad yn y nodyn hwn at Atodlen yn gyfeiriad at Atodlen i Offeryn 2016.

Mae rheoliad 3 yn galluogi defnyddio plât newydd ynghylch diogelwch ar y ffordd yn ychwanegol at yr arwyddion sy'n rhybuddio ynghylch plant ymhellach ymlaen yn mynd i'r ysgol neu oddi yno, neu'n mynd i faes chwarae neu oddi yno, neu ynghylch twmpathau ffordd. Mae hefyd yn galluogi cael plât sy'n rhybuddio ynghylch ardal tawelu traffig gydag arwydd ar gyfer twmpathau ffordd.

Mae rheoliad 4 yn diwygio cymhwysiad yr arwyddion a ddefnyddir i hysbysu am fynedfa ac allanfa parth 20 mya fel na ellir eu defnyddio yng Nghymru mwyach. O ganlyniad i ostwng y terfyn cyflymder cyffredinol ar gyfer ffyrdd cyfyngedig o 30 mya i 20 mya yng Nghymru, ni fydd parthau 20 mya yn angenrheidiol mwyach a byddant felly yn cael eu diddymu.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Instrument)

This Instrument amends the Traffic Signs Regulations 2016 and the Traffic Signs General Directions 2016, together cited as the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 ("the 2016 Instrument"). These amendments are only relevant to Wales and are consequential on and supplementary to the Restricted Roads (20 mph Speed Limit) (Wales) Order 2022, which reduces the general speed limit for restricted roads from 30 mph to 20 mph in Wales from 17 September 2023. A reference in this note to a Schedule is to a Schedule to the 2016 Instrument.

Regulation 3 enables a new road safety plate to be used in addition to the signs which warn of children going to or from school or playground ahead, or of road humps. It also enables a sign for road humps to be accompanied by a plate warning of a traffic calmed area.

Regulation 4 amends the application of the signs used to notify of the entrance to and exit from a 20 mph zone so that they can no longer be used in Wales. As a consequence of the general speed limit for restricted roads being reduced from 30 mph to 20 mph in Wales, 20 mph zones will no longer be necessary and will therefore be abolished.

Mae rheoliad 5 yn galluogi defnyddio dau arwydd newydd. Bydd un arwydd yn cael ei ddefnyddio i rybuddio ynghylch diwedd ardal tawelu traffig a bydd yr arwydd arall yn cael ei ddefnyddio i rybuddio ynghylch camera cyflymder ymhellach ymlaen ac i atgoffa gyrwyr o'r terfyn cyflymder 20 mya. Ni fydd yr arwydd cyfatebol sy'n atgoffa gyrwyr o'r terfyn cyflymder 30 mya yn gymwys i Gymru mwyach er mwyn adlewyrchu'r gostyngiad i'r terfyn cyflymder cyffredinol ar gyfer ffyrdd cyfyngedig.

Mae rheoliad 6 yn galluogi defnyddio arwydd newydd i rybuddio neu nodi bod terfyn cyflymder 20 mya newydd yn cychwyn. Ni fydd yr arwydd cyfatebol sy'n dynodi man cychwyn terfyn cyflymder 30 mya newydd yn gymwys i Gymru mwyach er mwyn adlewyrchu'r gostyngiad i'r terfyn cyflymder cyffredinol ar gyfer ffyrdd cyfyngedig.

Mae rheoliad 9 yn gwahardd defnyddio arwyddion ategu ar ffyrdd sy'n ddarostyngedig i derfyn cyflymder uchaf o 20 mya ac sydd â system goleuo cerbyttyrdd.

Mae rheoliad 10 yn cyfyngu ar ddefnyddio'r arwydd newydd a gyflwynir yn rheoliad 6 sy'n rhybuddio neu'n nodi bod terfyn cyflymder 20 mya newydd yn cychwyn. Ni ellir defnyddio'r arwydd ar ffordd sydd â therfyn cyflymder 20 mya a osodwyd yn ddiweddar ond yn ystod y cyfnod o 12 mis gan ddechrau â'r diwrnod y daw'r terfyn cyflymder 20 mya newydd i rym.

Mae rheoliad 11 yn ddarpariaeth drosiannol ac arbedion sy'n gymwys i Offeryn 2016. Mae arwyddion a oedd yn eu lle cyn i'r Offeryn hwn ddod i rym ac a oedd yn cydymffurfio ag Offeryn 2016 fel yr oedd mewn grym cyn y diwygiadau a wneir gan yr Offeryn hwn i'w trin fel pe baent yn parhau i gydymffurfio ag Offeryn 2016. Bydd y ddarpariaeth drosiannol ac arbedion yn peidio â chael effaith ar ôl 12 mis, heblaw mewn perthynas â'r marc ffordd sy'n dynodi'r terfyn cyflymder uchaf a fydd yn peidio â chael effaith ar ôl 5 mlynedd. Ni fydd y ddarpariaeth drosiannol ac arbedion yn gymwys i'r arwydd sy'n rhybuddio ynghylch camera cyflymder ymhellach ymlaen ar ffordd a gaiff ei goleuo ac sy'n atgoffa gyrwyr o derfyn cyflymder 30 mya.

Ystyriwyd Cod Ymarfer Gweinidogion Cymru ar gynnal Aseidiadau Effaith Rheoleiddiol mewn perthynas â'r Offeryn hwn. O ganlyniad, ystyriwyd nad oedd yn angenrheidiol cynnal aseiad effaith rheoleiddiol o'r costau a'r manteision sy'n debygol o ddeillio o gydymffurfio â'r Offeryn hwn.

Regulation 5 enables two new signs to be used. One sign will be used to warn of the end of a traffic calmed area and the other to warn of a speed camera ahead and remind drivers of the 20 mph speed limit. The corresponding sign reminding drivers of the 30 mph speed limit will no longer apply to Wales to reflect the reduction in the general speed limit for restricted roads.

Regulation 6 enables a new sign to be used to warn of or indicate the commencement of a new 20 mph speed limit. The corresponding sign indicating the commencement point of a new 30 mph speed limit will no longer apply to Wales to reflect the reduction in the general speed limit for restricted roads.

Regulation 9 prohibits the use of repeater signs on roads subject to a maximum speed limit of 20 mph and which have a system of carriageway lighting.

Regulation 10 restricts the use of the new sign introduced in regulation 6 warning of or indicating the commencement of a new 20 mph speed limit. The sign can only be used on a road with a recently imposed speed limit of 20 mph during the period of 12 months beginning with the day on which the new 20 mph speed limit comes into force.

Regulation 11 is a transitional and savings provision which applies to the 2016 Instrument. Signs which were in place prior to the coming into force of this Instrument and which complied with the 2016 Instrument as in force before the amendments made by this Instrument are to be treated as continuing to comply with the 2016 Instrument. The transitional and savings provision will cease to have effect after 12 months, save for in relation to the road marking indicating the maximum speed limit which will cease to have effect after 5 years. The transitional and savings provision will not apply to the sign warning of a speed camera ahead on a lit road and reminding drivers of a 30 mph speed limit.

The Welsh Ministers' Code of Practice on the carrying out of Regulatory Impact Assessments was considered in relation to this Instrument. As a result, it was not considered necessary to carry out a regulatory impact assessment as to the likely costs and benefits of complying with this Instrument.

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod perthnasol, yn gwneud y Rheoliadau yn Rhan 1 o'r Offeryn hwn drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir gan adran 64(1), (2) a (3) o Ddeddf Rheoleiddio Traffig Ffyrdd 1984(1) ("Deddf 1984") fel y maent wedi eu hestyn gan adran 26(3) o Ddeddf yr Iaith Gymraeg 1993(2).

The Welsh Ministers, being the relevant authority, make the Regulations in Part 1 of this Instrument in exercise of the powers conferred by section 64(1), (2) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1) ("the 1984 Act") as extended by section 26(3) of the Welsh Language Act 1993(2).

Mae Gweinidogion Cymru, sef yr awdurdod perthnasol a'r awdurdod cenedlaethol, yn rhoi'r Cyfarwyddydau Cyffredinol yn Rhan 2 o'r Offeryn hwn drwy arfer y pwerau a roddir gan adrannau 65(1)(3) a 85(2)(4) o Ddeddf 1984.

Title, application and coming into force

- 1.—(1) This Part of this Instrument may be cited—

- (2) These Regulations come into force on 17 September 2023.

Title, application and coming into force

7.—(1) This Part of this Instrument may be cited—

- (a) as the Traffic Signs (Amendment) (Wales) General Directions 2023, and
- (b) together with Part 1, as the Traffic Signs (Amendment) (Wales) Regulations and General Directions 2023.

(2) These General Directions come into force on 17 September 2023.

Amendment to the Traffic Signs General Directions 2016

8. The Traffic Signs General Directions 2016(1) are amended in accordance with regulations 9 and 10.

Amendment of Schedule 10

9. In Schedule 10, in Part 4 (The Schedule 10 General Directions) for paragraph 2, substitute—

“2. This sign must not be placed as a repeater sign where—

- (a) in relation to England, the road is subject to a maximum speed limit of 30 mph and has a system of carriageway lighting; or
- (b) in relation to Wales, the road is subject to a maximum speed limit of 20 mph and has a system of carriageway lighting.”

Amendment of Schedule 13

10. In Schedule 13, in Part 12 (The Schedule 13 General Directions) after paragraph 13, insert—

“13A. The sign may only be placed—

- (a) to indicate or give warning of the point at which a recently imposed speed limit of 20 mph begins on a road; and
- (b) during the period of 12 months beginning with the day on which the 20 mph speed limit comes into force.”

Transitional and savings provision

11.—(1) A traffic sign is to be treated as complying with the 2016 Instrument as amended by this Instrument where—

- (a) the traffic sign was in place immediately before 17 September 2023,
- (b) the traffic sign complies with the 2016 Instrument as in force immediately before 17 September 2023, and
- (c) the traffic sign is not in compliance with the 2016 Instrument as amended by this Instrument.

(2) But paragraph (1)—

- (a) ceases to apply to traffic signs prescribed by item 9 in the table at Part 2 of Schedule 10 to the 2016 Instrument at the end of the day on 16 September 2028;
- (b) ceases to apply to any other traffic signs at the end of the day on 16 September 2024.

(3) Paragraph (1) does not apply to traffic signs prescribed by item 64 in the table in Part 2 of Schedule 11 to the 2016 Instrument.

(4) In this regulation—

- (a) “the 2016 Instrument” means the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;
- (b) “traffic sign” has the meaning given in section 64(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
