### **CHAPTER 47**

## REPATRIATION OF PRISONERS ACT 1984

Transfer of prisoners to or from the United Kingdom

- 1 Issue of warrant for transfer.

Transfer of responsibility for detention and release of offender present outside the country or territory in which he is required to be detained
