TRAMWAYS ACT 1870

Provisional Orders authorizing the Construction of Tramways

- 4 By whom Provisional Orders authorising the construction of tramways may be obtained.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

Carriages

Licences to use Tramways

- 35 Licences to use the tramway may in certain events be granted to third parties by the Board of Trade.
- 36 In default of payment of tolls licensee’s carriages may be detained and sold.
- 37 Licensees to give account of passengers carried by them.
- 38 Licensees not giving account of passengers carried liable to penalty.
- 39 Disputes as to amount of toll to be settled by justice.
- 40 Owners of carriages liable for damage done by their servants.

Discontinuance of Tramways

- 41 Tramways to be removed in certain cases.

Insolvency of Promoters

- 42 Proceedings in case of insolvency of promoters.

Purchase of Tramways

- 43 Future purchase of undertaking by local authority.
