# 1895 CHAPTER 9 58 and 59 Vict

An Act to apply the Documentary Evidence Acts to the Board of Agriculture. [14th May 1895]

## 1 Application of Documentary Evidence Acts to Board of Agriculture.

The <sup>M1</sup>Documentary Evidence Act 1868, as amended by the <sup>M2</sup>Documentary Evidence Act 1882, shall apply to the Board of Agriculture in like manner as if that Board were mentioned in the first column of the schedule to the first-mentioned Act, and the President or any member of the Board, or the Secretary of the Board, or any person authorised by the President to act on behalf of the Secretary of the Board, were mentioned in the second column of that schedule, and as if the regulations referred to in those Acts included any document issued by the Board.
