The Tokyo Convention Act 1967 (Commencement No. 2)

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 28th day of November 1969

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by section 9(3) of the Tokyo Convention Act 1967(a) and of all other powers enabling Her in that behalf, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

1. Section 2 of the Tokyo Convention Act 1967 shall come into force on 4th December 1969.
2. This Order may be cited as the Tokyo Convention Act 1967 (Commencement No. 2) Order 1969.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

The Tokyo Convention Act 1967, except section 2 (which makes provisions as to extradition), was brought into force on 1st April 1968 by the Tokyo Convention Act 1967 (Commencement) Order 1968 (S.I. 1968/469). This Order brings section 2 into force on 4th December 1969, the date notified by the International Civil Aviation Organisation, in pursuance of Article 26 of the Convention on Offences and certain other Acts Committed on board Aircraft (Cmnd. 2261) signed in Tokyo on 14th September 1963, as the date on which that Convention comes into force. The Convention has been ratified by the United Kingdom.
