**The Social Security Act 1998 (Commencement
No. 8, and Savings and Consequential
and Transitional Provisions) Order 1999**

Appointed day

2.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2) below and to articles 3 and 5 of this Order, 5th July 1999 is the day appointed for the coming into force of—

- (a) paragraph 105 of Schedule 7 (co-ordination with Northern Ireland), and section 86(1) in so far as it relates to that paragraph; and
- (b) the provisions of the Act specified in Schedule 1 to this Order, in so far as those provisions are not already in force, for the purposes of—
 - (i) guardian’s allowance under Part III of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992 ^{M1},
 - (ii) benefits under Part V of that Act (benefits for industrial injuries),
 - (iii) child benefit, and
 - (iv) any matter to which, by virtue of section 170 of the Pension Schemes Act 1993 ^{M2}, provisions of Chapter II of Part I of the Act are to apply.

(2) Paragraphs 63 and 102 of Schedule 7 shall come into force immediately before, respectively, paragraphs 4 and 14 of Schedule 7 to the Social Security Contributions (Transfer of Functions, etc.) Act 1999 ^{M3} come into force.
