The Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Act 2002 (Commencement No. 1, Savings and Transitional Provisions) (Wales) Order 2002

Citation, interpretation and extent

- **1.**—(1) This Order may be cited as the Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Act 2002 (Commencement No. 1, Savings and Transitional Provisions) (Wales) Order 2002.
 - (2) In this Order—
 - "the 1967 Act" ("Deddf 1967") means the Leasehold Reform Act 1967(1);
 - "the 1993 Act" ("Deddf 1993") means the Leasehold Reform, Housing and Urban Development Act 1993(2);
 - "the commencement date" ("y dyddiad cychwyn") means 1st January 2003; and references to sections and schedules are, unless otherwise stated, references to sections of, and Schedules to, the Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Act 2002.
 - (3) This Order applies to Wales only.

Provisions coming into force on the commencement date

- **2.** The following provisions of the Commonhold and Leasehold Reform Act 2002 shall come into force on the commencement date—
 - (a) sections 114, 129, 132, 133, 137 and 142;
 - (b) subject to the transitional provisions and savings in Schedule 2 to this Order—
 - (i) sections 115 to 120, 125, 127, 128, 130, 131, 134 to 136, 138 to 141, 143 to 147, 160 to 162; and
 - (ii) section 180 in so far as it relates to those of the repeals in Schedule 14 which are set out in Schedule 1 to this Order;
 - (c) sections 74, 78, 80, 84, 92, 110, 122, 151 to 153, 156, 164, 166, 167, 171, 174 and Schedule 12, in so far as they confer power to make regulations.
